School Up gradation:

School has applied for CBSE affiliation for upgradation to Senior Secondary Level and inspection was held on 08th August 2024.



Academics:

- The Second batch of HNPS achieved 100% results, with all 32 students showing outstanding performance in the CBSE class 10 Board examination.
- The commendable SAFAL Exam result. Classes 5 & 8 had appeared for English, Mathematics, and Science/EVS and placed in the Proficient level in all three subjects. 2024-25 SAFAL result awaited.
- Curio Curriculum, an activity-based curriculum introduced in Bal Vatika I, II & III and Grade 1 and Grade 2. The company provides activity-based textbooks, workbooks, Handbooks for parents & teachers, lesson plans and content through Moodle App.
- NCERT and CBSE curriculum-based workbooks and NCERT Exemplars are provided to students along with textbooks for additional practice.
- Moodle Learning Management system implemented in classes 3-10. Self-learning content, such as revision notes & quiz as part of multiple assessment is uploaded on Moodle.
- To prepare students for SAFAL Exams, chapter tests are being conducted on Moodle.

Infrastructure

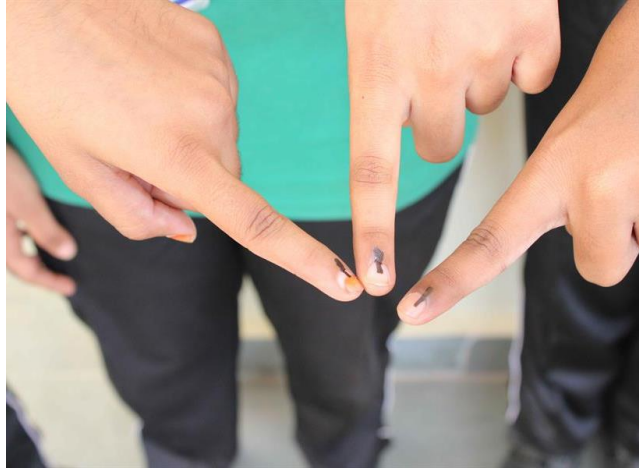
- Phase II construction of the New Building is completed, and Phase III is ongoing and is expected to complete by November 2024.
